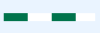

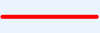

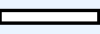
Snowshoe Route

Sno-Park Access Road



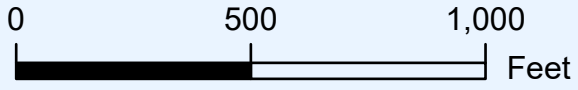
WA State Park Boundaries

100 foot contour interval

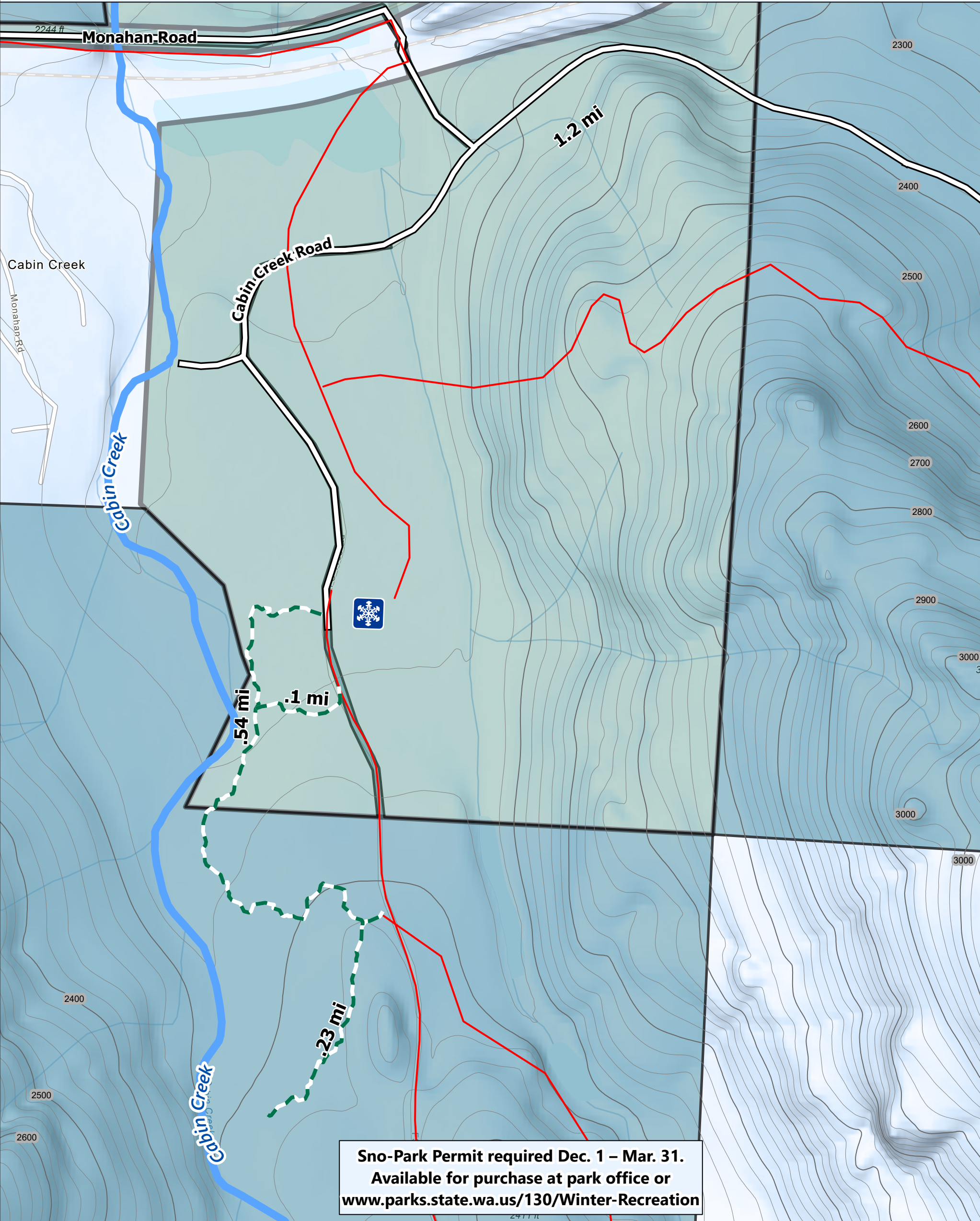
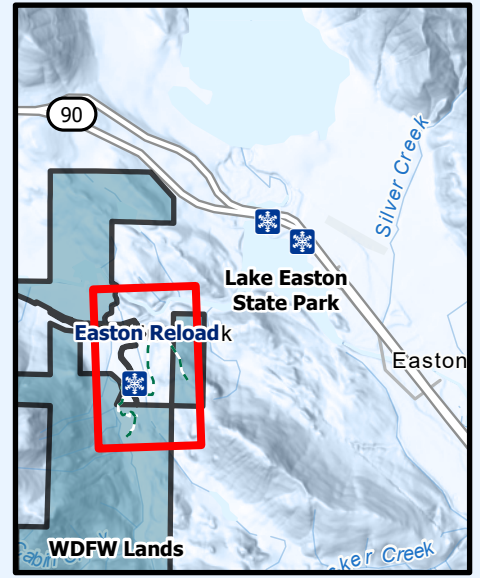
20 foot contour interval
