





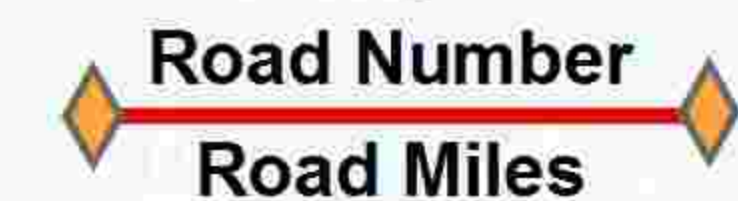


Welcome Government Mineral Springs Groomed Trail System
