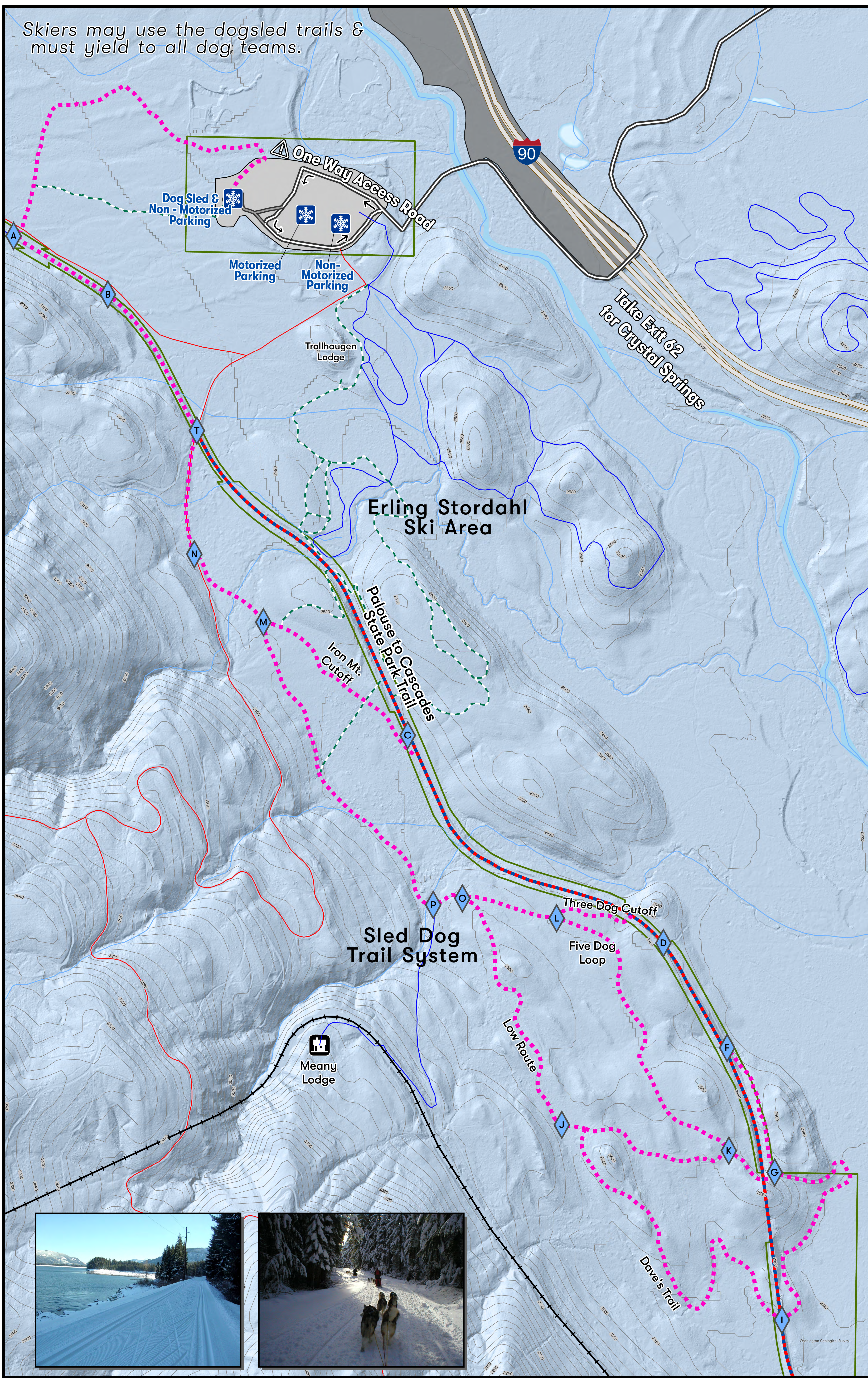


Skiers may use the dogsled trails & must yield to all dog teams.

Area has 10 miles (16 km) of sled dog trails.

**No dogs or snowshoes on groomed ski track. Do not walk on the groomed trail. Downhill skiers have the right of way. Trails may become more difficult during icy conditions.**

**Snow grooming equipment may be on the trail at any time. Trail grooming schedules may change without notice due to snow conditions, temperatures, equipment breakdowns, etc.**
