


Blake Island Marine State Park





Tillicum Village

- Early 1960s: Parks acquires land and structures in Tillicum Village built
- 1962: Tillicum Village founded and operated by Bill Hewitt to coincide with Seattle World Fair
- 2009: Argosy acquires concession, remodeled and updated programming in 2011
- 2021: Argosy ends concession









Marina Project

- Design and Permit not funded in 2023-25 Capital Request
- Requested for 2025-27 for \$2.8 million
- Master Plan can inform Marina



Planning Approach

Previous Approach:

- Replace Concessionaire
- Ask for interested parties to reach out


Updated Approach:

- Waste








Tribal Outreach
