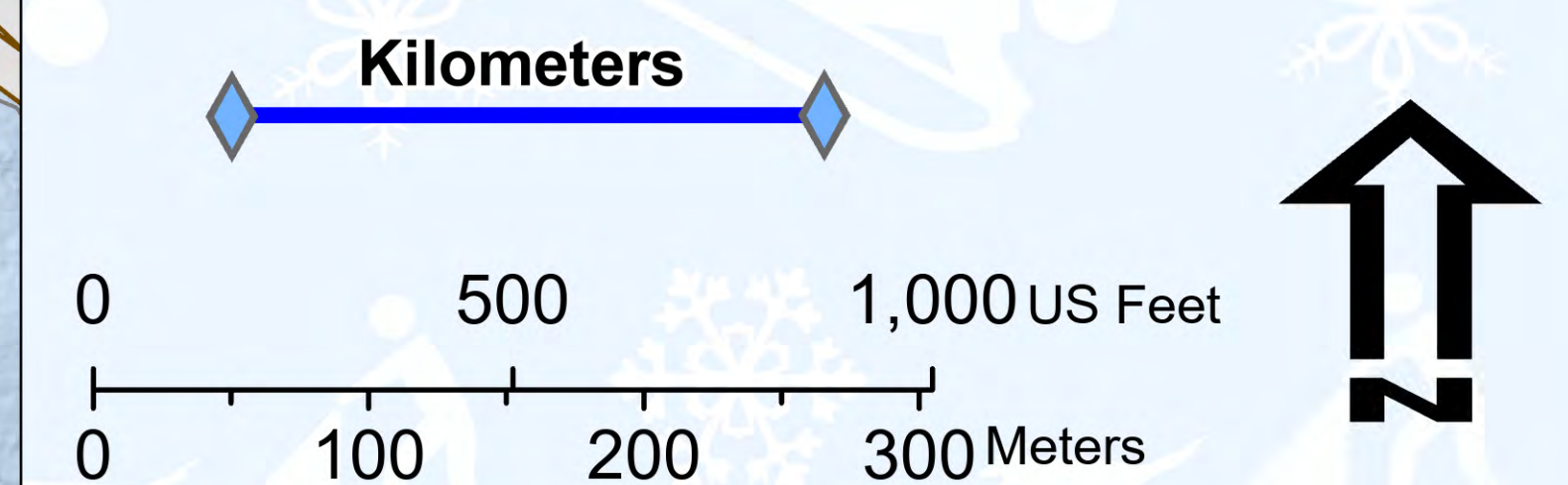


Welcome Crystal Springs Sno-Park Groomed Trail System

Snow grooming equipment may be on the trail at any time. Trail grooming schedules may change without notice due to snow conditions, temperatures, equipment breakdowns, etc.

Be aware of potential avalanche danger, check www.nwac.us before you leave home.

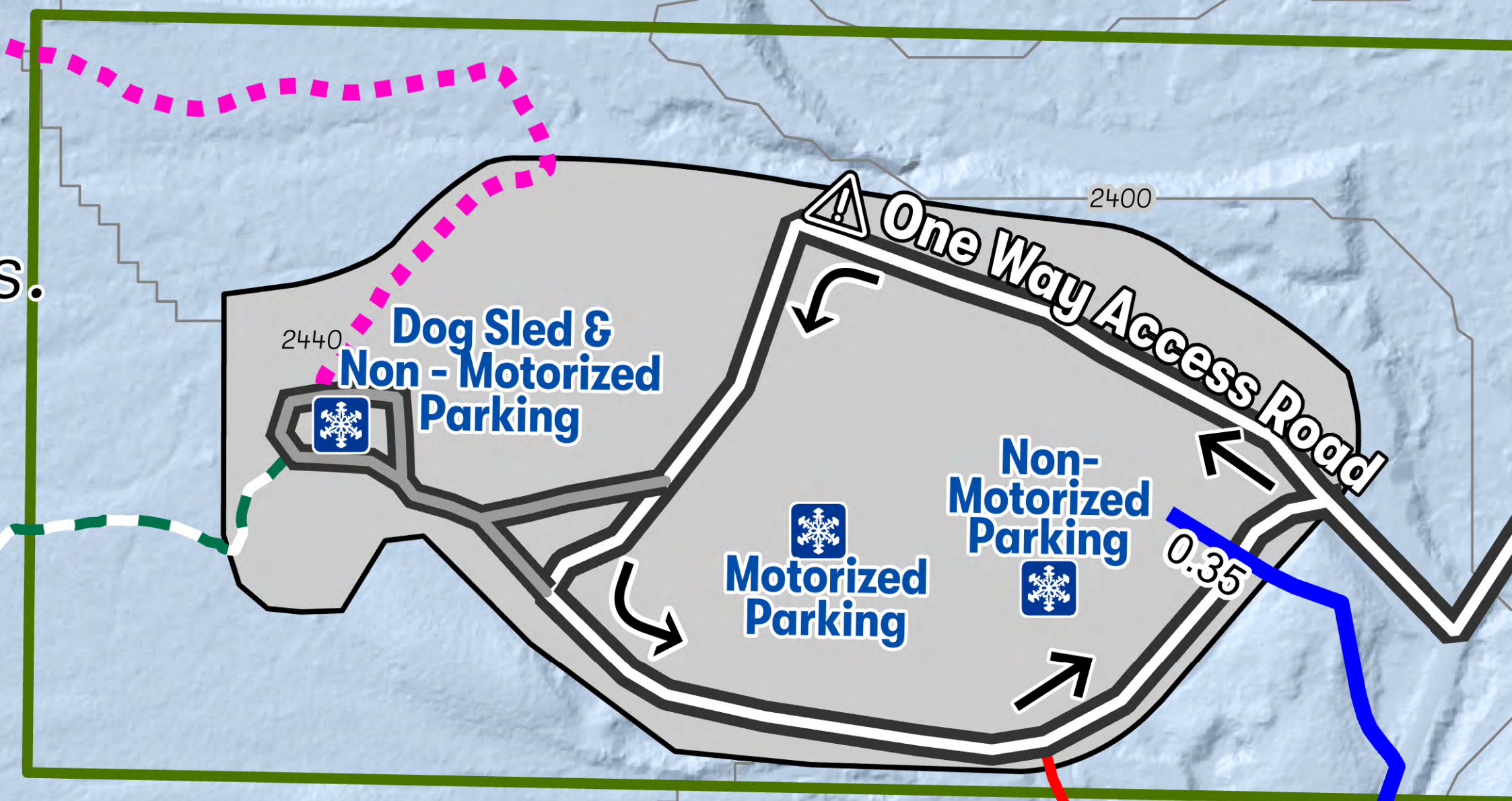
