THINGS TO DO

Coast Artillery Museum: Military history and exhibits of Fort Worden from its beginnings in 1897 through the end of the coast defense era.

Commanding Officer's Quarters Museum: Visit the museum to get a glimpse of the commanding officer's family life.

Hike the Fort: 12 miles of trails, explore coast defense batteries, views of the Strait of Juan de Fuca and variety of ecosystems.

Makers Square: A collective of independent arts, cultural, wellness and yoga organizations.

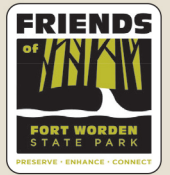
